Last summer, many of you may have seen our vegetable garden located up the hill from the Veranda. This year, Gwen Norris and her landscaping crew have kicked it up a notch and added an extensive mix of all-organic vegetables and native flora to be used in our kitchen and restaurant.



Additions to the garden include Heirloom Tomatoes such as Brandywine and Cherokee Purple, Heirloom Cucumbers, French Climbing Beans, Lettuce, Spinach, Arugula, Peppers, Onions, Fennel, Leeks, and Corn. Gwen is also putting potatoes in the mix, an addition she's excited about.

An herb garden will allow our Chef to make use of fresh herbs on a daily basis; some you might see in the garden are Parsley, Thyme, Chives, Oregano, Lemongrass and Horseradish.

The cutting garden is also new; you'll see brightly-colored fresh flowers sprinkled throughout the restaurant for the spring and summer.

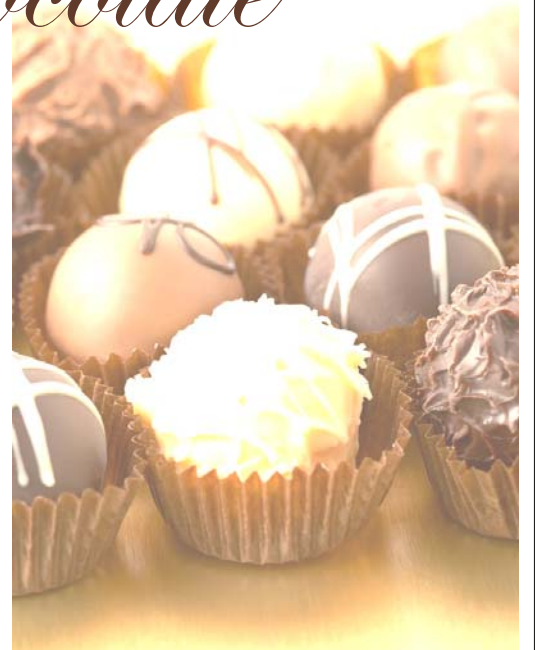
